The Camden Art Prize Inc is conducting The 36th Camden Art Prize in 2011.

The Main Aims of the Committee are:

To stage the Camden Art Prize
To promote the visual arts within the local government area of Camden and district, and to broaden and stimulate community perception of art with particular reference to Australian works.

2011 Conditions of Entry

PLEASE NOTE: Many changes since 2009 marked with an asterisk *

Entries

Works must be the original work of the entrant, must have been completed in the last 12 months and must not have been exhibited in any previous competition in the Camden, Campbelltown or Wollondilly local government areas.

Local Section is restricted to any artist residing in the local Government areas of Camden, Wollondilly and Campbelltown.

* A maximum of two (2) works may be entered and all works must remain for the duration of the exhibition.

* Submission of Entry Form

*Entries must be on a copy of the entry form and received by 4:00pm Friday 15th April together with the entry fee of \$20 per entry.

* Late entries will incur a \$5.00 penalty per entry.

Size of Entries

Size of works must be within 1.0sq m. in area, including frame.

* Sculptures must be within: 100cm wide x 100cm high x 100cm deep.

Presentation

Artworks must be ready for hanging with **SCREWS AND WIRES ATTACHED**, and be **CLEARLY MARKED ON THE BACK** with **NAME, ADDRESS, CONTACT PHONE NUMBER, TITLE OF WORK, SECTION** and **PRICE**.

Commission

Every work must be for sale and a commission of 25% of sale price will be retained by the Committee on sales. If artist is registered for GST, the sale price MUST include GST.

Receiving and Collection of Artworks

Eligible work will be accepted by the Committee at the Camden Civic Centre, Oxley Street, Camden on Saturday 30 April from 9:00am to 4:00pm.

Exhibitors must arrange their own delivery of works, but the following agent has indicated that he will deliver items which are properly wrapped, up to 2 artworks per parcel.

Sold and unsold works will be available for collection on Friday 14th May between 4:30 and 6:00 and Saturday 15th May from 8:30 to 12:00 midday. **Receipt must be presented to collect artwork.**

PLEASE NOTE: A \$20 late pick up fee will apply in 2011.

Entries not collected within 2 weeks of Exhibition closure may be disposed of at the discretion of the committee.

Judging

The decision of the judges is final.

Copyright

The organisers reserve the right to have any work reproduced in the press, on television or the committee's website for promotional purposes. Further, the organisers reserve the right to have the winning entry in any section reproduced in full colour, as a magazine illustration. Copyright claims, for these purposes only, will be deemed to be waived by the artist when work is submitted.

Insurance Cover

The committee will exercise reasonable care with all works submitted but will not be responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any such works while in its custody. Exhibitors are responsible for maintaining their own insurance cover.

PLEASE BE AWARE:

- Entry fees are non-refundable.
- Committee will hang works at their discretion; not all works will necessarily be hung.
- Committee members may enter works for sale on a non competitive basis.

Graham Cox

Graham Cox became a professional artist in 1977 after spending many years working towards a unique portrayal of the Australian Landscape.

He is widely known both here and overseas for his work. With 65 one-man exhibitions to his credit, including an impressive record of important commissions, he is now frequently sought as a judge.

Graham believes in encouraging others in their efforts and to this end enjoys tutoring occasionally in workshops.

Krysten Walker-Cox

Krysten Walker-Cox, a professional sculptor/artist has been creating beautiful figurative works in bronze, ceramic and timber for many years.

Her fascination with the human figure has led to many important commissions, the first of which, at the age of 19, brought her to notice as a rare talent.

She lives and works in the lower Hunter Valley along with her husband, Graham Cox.
